

Beaver County Head Start is a comprehensive child development program servicing children ages 3-5 and their families. It is designed to increase school readiness and develop their fullest potential. Beaver County Head Start serves over 650 families throughout Beaver County.



Program Options

Both options provide free pre-school programming and meals. Our full day classrooms operate from 6am to 6pm and offer before and after preschool school care to parents who are working or in school.

Eligibility

All families living in Beaver County with children between the ages of 3 and 5 are encouraged to apply. While eligibility is based on income guidelines, families that receive certain benefits are eligible as well. We also enroll 10% of our families over our income guidelines.

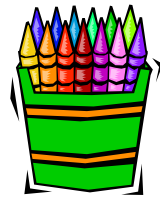
